The North Dakota Conservation Forage Program

CFP will work with North Dakota's producers to restore marginal crop lands back to grasslands to improve forage availability and quality. By providing support through financial and technical assistance to landowners, CFP aims to accelerate grassland restoration and recover overall soil health and grassland bird habitat across the state.



Financial Assistance

3-year establishment payments
based on local county averages



Cost Share

60% forage seed mix cost share
50% grazing infrastructure cost
share.
\$20/acre for seeding labor

*Project is encouraged to be grazed
or hayed once fully established to
provide income on the property
after year 3.*

10 year term agreement

Unlike CRP, the CFP is
targeted at increasing the
acres available for grazing
and haying, producers are
encouraged to create a
haying or grazing plan.
